Multiplatinum singer-songwriter **Sam Barber** turns the page on his next chapter with the release of his new single “**Borrowed Time**” out now via Atlantic Music Group’s **Atlantic Outpost**. Listen [HERE](#). Stewarding his unfiltered creative vision, the acclaimed troubadour penned the song and co-produced it alongside frequent collaborator **Joe Becker**.

“Borrowed Time” laces no-nonsense old-school country lyricism into an electric framework, rooted in rock instrumentation and folk soul. The track untangles complicated emotions over the echoes of palm-muted power chords. His vocals quake through a haze of feedback as he urges, “*Before you leave, take your disease.*” Acoustic guitar entwines with a sparse beat on the bridge while Sam shakes off the past and moves on with lines like, “*You think this hurts, but I’m so far from losing sleep.*”

Just last month, Barber unveiled **Live From 2025**, showcasing his incredible live performances from time spent on road last year. He’s currently canvassing the country on “**The American Route**,” an epic US headline tour that will carry him through June. Along the way, he will make his much-anticipated return to Indio, CA’s Stagecoach Music Festival on April 24. ABOUT SAM BARBER:

With **more than 3.3B** global streams to date, Sam Barber claimed his space in the country spotlight with the breakout success of his RIAA Gold-certified 2024 debut album, *Restless Mind* — a 28-song tour-de-force highlighted by such smash singles as the 2x RIAA Platinum certified "Straight and Narrow," "Better Year" (an emotionally charged anthem featured on Paramount Network's blockbuster TV show *Yellowstone*), and the RIAA Platinum-certified "Indigo (Feat. Avery Anna)," the latter of which has proven a worldwide sensation with **over 709M** global streams, climbing to the upper reaches of country radio airplay charts nationwide, and reaching the top 40 on *Billboard's* overall "Hot 100." Barber's "Tear Us Apart" was among the standout tracks featured on the GRAMMY® Award-nominated blockbuster soundtrack, *Twisters: The Album*. Barber kept his unstoppable momentum going with his 2025 EP, *Music for the Soul*. Co-written by Barber and produced by GRAMMY® Award-winner Ryan Hewitt (The Lumineers, Noah Kahan) and Joe Becker at studios in Nashville, TN and Bozeman, MT, the EP sees Barber chronicling how he got here and where he's headed next on such eloquent, empathetic new songs as "Same Sad Shit" and the fame-wrestling title track, "Music for the Soul." A truly enthralling live performer, Barber marked his meteoric rise by spending much of his time on the road, including the massive *Restless Mind World Tour 2025*, a marathon international run that saw sold-out headline dates and festival appearances across North America, the United Kingdom, Europe, and Australia. The 22-year-old Southeast Missouri-raised singer-songwriter further celebrated his ascent with high-profile TV performances on NBC's *The Kelly Clarkson Show* and CBS *Saturday Morning's* "Saturday Sessions."
